Full Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival and Overnight in Nairobi:

Arrive in Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, flight TBA. Meet safari driver-guide and after safari briefing, transfer to your city hotel for overnight. Lunch and Dinner on own arrangements; pay direct.

Day 2: Nairobi to Masai Mara Game Reserve

Breakfast in the city hotel and depart for Masai Mara Game reserve driving along the bottom of the Rift Valley to Masai Mara Game Reserve. The jewel in Africa's crown, Masai Mara, is host to the most spectacular array of wildlife; lions, elephant, giraffe, a variety of gazelle species, zebras among others. Rare animals are Cheetah, leopard and Rhinos but are still spotted. Game viewing is never dull in the Mara and patience is often rewarded with unique sightings: a pride of lion stalking their prey; a solitary leopard retrieving its kill from the high branches of an acacia tree; a male wildebeest sparring to attract females into their harem; a herd of elephant protecting their young from opportunistic predators.

We will proceed to our camp for a late lunch. This afternoon we will enjoy a drive through this spectacular game area before returning to camp for dinner this evening.

Afternoon Visit to a Maasai Cultural Village: *This afternoon, join the Maasai dancers donning their African regalia and the jingling on their feet, flow by the rhythm of African beats and dance to their tunes that will leave you refreshed.*

Day 3: Full Day in Masai Mara Game Reserve

Breakfast in the hotel and depart for a full day game drive with picnic lunch boxes or enjoy morning and afternoon game drives in Masai Mara Game Reserve with lunch break in between the game drives.

The Mara is the northern extension of the Serengeti and its rolling plains are home to hundreds of plains game together with predators that feed on them.

Optional Masai Mara Balloon Ride: *for those going for the balloon safari, you will be going for the early morning balloon, you will be picked at the hotel by the Balloon Company at 5.30am and drive to the balloon launch site where you will gather for takeoff. Enjoy early morning ballooning over the plains, getting a bird's eye view of the game below as the sun creeps slowly over the horizon. After approximately one hour aloft, the balloon lands while a breakfast is being prepared for us nearby. The smell of bacon, sausages and eggs drift on the breeze as we sample exotic Kenyan fruits and homemade pastries and, if you wish, glasses of bubbly to toast our flight, a tradition initiated by the Montgolfier brothers. Day 4: Masai Mara Game Reserve to Lake Nakuru National Park

Breakfast in the lodge and depart for Lake Nakuru National Park heading straight for a game drive to the world-famous haunt for pink flamingos, is a shallow alkaline lake in Kenya's Rift Valley and some 62 km² in extent.

Lake Nakuru National Park: Established in 1961 and gazette in 1968 as a National Park, the park has Kenya's largest population of rhinos. The park is home to Lion Hills, Makalia waterfalls, unique vegetation, Picturesque landscape, yellow acacia woodlands and a wide range of birds most famous being Flamingoes and Pelicans. Located in the Great Rift Valley Lake System, the park is also as an ecologically significant region having been named a RAMSAR Site and Important Bird Area. Covering 73 square miles (188 square kilometers), Lake Nakuru is world famous for flamingos, and was created a National Park to protect, its stunning flocks of lesser flamingo which literally turn its shores pink. These are the millions of flamingoes seeking their food in the salty deep-green waters of Lake Nakuru.

Animals include: White Rhinos, Black Rhinos, Lions, buffaloes, leopards, hippos, giraffes, waterbucks, Thomson gazelles, Grants gazelles, impalas, waterbucks, White and Black Colobus monkey, giraffes and about 450 birds species in total. The bush lands offer eland, Steinbok, impala, Chandler's Reedbuck and dik dik a home, whilst rock hyrax and klipspringer occupy the cliffs and escarpment. The park is indeed a birds' paradise hosting over 500 species.

Day 5: Lake Nakuru National Park to Nairobi then take a train to Mombasa for Beach Vacation

You are booked on an afternoon Train from Nairobi to Mombasa; First Class coach

- *You also have an option of flying from Nairobi, directly to Mombasa; (45Mins). Price range; US \$150-190**

Early morning breakfast in the hotel and enjoy a game drive in the park as you exit and head to Nairobi. Arrive in Nairobi and transfer to the train station for your scheduled train to Mombasa. Alternatively, we can have a brief lunch stopover (time allowing) where you can have lunch at a city restaurant (own arrangement-pay direct). Afterwards, transfer to the train station in time for your scheduled afternoon train to Mombasa, upon arrival in Mombasa train station, you will be met by our representative who will transfer you to your beach hotel.
