DETAILED FULL ITINERARY.

DAY 1 – ARRIVAL IN NAIROBI/ ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK L, D.

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport with meet & greet by our representative/pick up from your Nairobi Hotel, you will meet your driver guide for safari briefing, drive to Aberdare National Park, arrive in time for lunch and check in, leisure, afternoon game viewing from your deck until sunset, have your dinner and overnight at your lodge.

The Ark Lodge; Set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, iconic and yes, quirky. The Ark overlooks a floodlit waterhole and salt lick, which attracts a host of awesome wildlife. Resembling and named after Noah’s Ark, The Ark comprises of three decks from which numerous balconies and lounges provide a superb location for wildlife to be seen. So that you don’t miss any animal sightings, the night guard will buzz your room when special animals come to the waterhole. The Ark has four viewing areas for observing the ever-present animal activity. There is also a ground level bunker – the perfect hideout for the discerning photographer. This is a circular pillbox-like structure, and it is from this vantage point that pictures of animals on the salt lick only yards away may be taken through the view holes in complete safety."In this intimate recess one can almost, but not quite, pat the animals, hear their sounds and smell the aroma of the night. This is a magical corner, where there is close contact with the essence that tells of an unexplored Africa, and where, very often, the visitor may enjoy in solitary state the beauty of it all."- Monty Brown's book, Haven Under the Hill.

Dinner & Overnight at The Ark Lodge on Full board basis.

DAY 2 – ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK/SAMBURU NATIONAL PARK B, L, D.

Breakfast at your Lodge, check out and drive to Samburu National Park, arrive in time for lunch and leisure, afternoon game drive until sunset, later return to you camp for diner and overnight.

Ashnil Samburu Camp; sits in Buffalo Springs Game Reserve which takes its name from an oasis of crystal-clear water at the western end of the reserve. It is separated from Samburu National Reserve by Ewaso Nyiro River and is less hilly and dense yet very attractive. There are a total number of 30 luxury tents; 18 doubles, 9 with twin beds and 3 with triple beds. Each of the exclusive comfortable deluxe tents provides a perfect view of the Ewaso Nyiro River and the beautiful surrounding landscape. Every spacious tent consists of a dressing area, sitting area, luggage rack and en-suite facilities to provide a memorable stay close to nature.

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Dinner & Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp on Full board basis.

DAY 3 – SAMBURU NATIONAL PARK B, L, D.

Breakfast at your camp, spend 01 full day in Samburu National Park, with morning and afternoon game drive, all meals will be served at the camp later return for dinner and overnight at your camp.

Dinner & Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp on Full board basis.

DAY 4 – SAMBURU NATIONAL PARK /OI PEJETA CONSERVANCY B, L, D.

Breakfast at your camp and drive to Ol Pejeta conservancy, arrive in time for lunch and leisure, afternoon private game drive in the conservancy until sunset, later return to your camp for dinner and overnight. There are also optional activities at Ol Pejeta conservancy that are available with extra cost given separately.

Sweetwaters Serena Camp; The Camp is located on the plains of Mount Kenya, clustered around a water hole and set in the pristine calm of the private Ol Pejeta Conservancy. The camp features 39 luxury tents. Each with its own private veranda overlooking the water hole and a private bathroom with a shower and toilet. The recently built Morani Wing features 17 spacious deluxe double, twin and triple tents. The central Rhino Restaurant offers both regional and international cuisine. The property offers a garden, a bar, swimming pool, private waterhole and night viewing bar, conference room, wedding planning, and honeymoon venue, gift shop, business center.

Dinner & Overnight at Ol Pejeta Serena Camp on Full board basis

DAY 5 – OI PEJETA CONSERVANCY/LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK B, L, D.

Breakfast at your camp and check out, drive to Lake Nakuru National Park to arrive in time for lunch at your camp, afternoon at leisure with game drive in the park, later return to your lodge for dinner and overnight.

Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge; Located on a range of hills that form the western limits of Africa's Great Rift Valley, the lodge offers spectacular views over the vastness of Africa. The lodge also overlooks Lake Nakuru and its surrounding National Park, one that is a paradise for bird watchers and wildlife lovers alike. Lake Nakuru National Park is mainly a wooded and bushy grassland with a wide ecological diversity and characteristic habitats that range from the lake waters to the escarpment and ridges. Situated in the Rift Valley, Lake Nakuru is the heart of a small national park, best known for its volcanic scenery and enormous populations of flamingos. Sightings of rhinos, lions and other animals are also possible. At 188 square kilometres, Lake Nakuru National Park is a relatively small fenced wildlife reserve, of which around a third is taken up by the lake itself. The area is most famous for its enormous populations of flamingos which nest along the shoreline. Depending on the season, there can be hundreds of thousands, possible even millions of these birds on view. The Park is also renowned for its populations of rare black rhinos, white rhinos and Rothschild giraffes. Predators including lions, leopards and cheetahs are also present and seen with reasonable regularity.

Dinner & Overnight at Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge on Full board basis.

DAY 6: LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK/MASAI MARA: B, L, D.

Breakfast at the camp and check out, depart for the famous Masai Mara National Reserve. Arrive in time for lunch and check inn at Mara Serena Lodge. Afternoon at Leisure with afternoon private game. Later

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return to your lodge for dinner and overnight. Spend 02 nights at the lodge/camp booked on full board basis.

Pride Inn Mara Camp; Scenic, beautiful, intimately personal. Pride Inn Mara Camp offers breathtaking views of Mara plains. The camp is set in an ideal location where wildlife plays their naughty games day and night. In fact, the edge of River Talek gives our guests a front view seat to wildlife drama. The iconic camp is set on a 25-acre of virgin and unspoiled savannah land along the banks of river Talek at the edge of the Masai Mara National Park. The Mara jewel is renowned for the finest, unrivalled first-class wildlife experiences at the world-famous Masai Mara National Reserve. It is the perfect, exclusive getaway lodge for the discerning traveller seeking to relax with a breathtaking view of the endless savannah grassland or a glass of champagne while marveling at the enchanting sundowner. Blessed with an abundance of wildlife and birds, you will encounter cheetahs, elephants, zebras and hippos during your stay with us or on your game drives. The strategic location of the camp also bequeaths you the first-row seat view of the spectacular Annual Wildebeest Migration, one of the greatest natural spectacles in the world. Enjoy superb luxury facilities, world-class service and an outstanding accommodation experience with a creative blend of art, comfort and the Masai Mara Safari experience.

Mara Sopa Lodge; Masai Mara Sopa Lodge is located high on the slopes of the Oloolaimutia Hills, Masai Mara Sopa Lodge was one of the first safari lodges to be built in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve, a reason why its gardens and trees are so lush and mature. All the buildings follow the design of traditional African round houses with conical roofs and these stretch along the line of the hills with the impressively large public area buildings and the swimming pool at their center. Masai Mara Sopa Guests are drawn to the ethnic design of this Lodge, which itself is surrounded by a landscape rich in flora, from wild olive, bitter aloe vera, croton and Mexican trees. The Lodge has 50 round buildings, each with two rooms. Eight of the 50 cottages at Masai Mara Sopa Lodge have interconnecting rooms. The honeymoon suite is situated at the top of the property providing an uninterrupted view. This very spacious suite has a king-size bed, a shower and a sunken bath. A spacious veranda is perfect to watch the sunset or enjoy private meals. There are 12 suites at Masai Mara Sopa Lodge, each with a large living area, spacious bedroom with either one king size bed or two queen-size beds, mosquito nets, en-suite bathroom with shower, coffee table with chairs and a mini-bar on request. The Masai Mara Sopa Lodge standard rooms equally have a choice of one king size bed or two queen size beds with mosquito nets and en-suite bathrooms with shower. Each has a veranda with two safari chairs.

Mara Loyk; Loyk Mara Luxury Camp is a Family Friendly Camp located in one of the most picturesque places on the bank of River Ntiakitiak on a 50 acres private land at the border of Olare Motorogi conservancy and Masai Mara National Reserve - the richest National Reserve of Kenya. Settled down in the middle of the African bush, Loyk Mara Luxury Camp will give you a sensation of privacy and rest, granting a vivifying cool under the shade of sprawling canopies of undersized trees within a hot day. They provide all necessary facilities for your comfort staying with children from 2 years old and above. We got baby friendly menu, baby chairs and baby cots upon your request. Besides all other facilities we have 24 hours electricity in both public and private areas at the Camp powered by solar panel with the diesel generator on backup, hot and cold-water showers, flushing toilets, intercoms, WiFi, DSTV and etc. They also have everything you may need to relax yourself and entertain your kids. Our naturalist will not only help you to discover more about wildlife while walking through the endless savannah with the Maasai Warriors and armed Ranger, but also will teach your children how to recognize and use different local

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plants and minerals, use the traditional Maasai bowl and spire, track the animals and much more. Our small traditional Maasai Manyatta within the Camp is open for every Guest during day or night. Here you and your kids will learn more about Maasai cultures, beadwork and traditional Maasai housekeeping.

You are always welcome to donate affordable funds to support local Maasai Community purchasing crafts you like from our giftshop. At our Lounge and Reception, we provide different table games, billiard and even open-air cinema to watch movies or cartoons in the evening time. And don't forget about the swimming pool - it's at your service through all seasons at Loyk.

Dinner & overnight at Mara Sopa Lodge/Mara Pride/Mara Loyk camp on Full board basis.

DAY 7: MASAI MARA: B, L, D.

One full day spent in the Mara Triangle Reserve with morning and afternoon game drives. Elephant and Buffalo abound in the riverine forests, while out on the grasslands Impala and Thompson's gazelle can be seen together with their attendant predators such as lion, Cheetah, Hyena and Jackal. The Mara is, in fact, the northern part of the Serengeti ecosystem and plays host to the vast herds of migratory wildebeest and zebra during the months of July to October. Lesser-known species such as topi, hartebeest, waterbuck Eland and many small mammals create a kaleidoscopic picture of wildlife. All meals and overnight stay will be at Mara Sopa Lodge/Pride Inn Mara/Mara Loyk Camp.

Dinner & overnight at Mara Sopa Lodge/Mara Pride/Mara Loyk camp on Full board basis.

DAY 8: MASAI MARA/NAIROBI/DEPART: B, L.

Breakfast at your Lodge/Camp and check out, with game drive enroute you will drive back to Nairobi and arrive in time for farewell lunch, later drop off at JKIA for your flight back home.
