Together with the guide the Naturanda group will depart from Seville, and will visit some of the most characteristic Andalusian White Villages. In addition to visiting characteristic White Villages within the region, the group will also visit the king of Castilla and Granada's fort, all within an excursion specifically designed to introduce visitors to Andalusian sites of cultural significance.

Upon travelling into the municipality of Coronil, the first site this group will visit is the medieval castle of Aguzaderas. When here, the guide will lead the visitors to the picturesque house of Zahara of the Sierra, where the group will visit the oil press of El Vinculo, founded in 1755 and dedicated to the extraction and elaboration of olive oil. Also while here, the visitors will have the opportunity to enjoy culinary delicacies of the area and make purchases of these products.

From Zahara de la Sierra, the group will be lead through the mountains of the Sierra of Grazalema, a mountain range of extraordinary historical, geographic, and natural importance.

When travelling through this region, some of the most characteristic forms of vegetation which can be found in this region include the tall firs and the Pinsipar forest. After this brief visit, visitors will then travel with the guide to the locality of Grazalema, which gave name to its accompanying Sierra. While here, visitors will be able to enjoy the fantastic views and delicious food which can be enjoyed within this village.

To conclude the tour, the Naturanda guide will accompany visitors to the mythical and romantic city of Ronda as visitors enjoy views of the Ronda mountain range and the vultures that fly over the region. Upon arrival in the city, the group will be brought to the Alameda, the walk of the bullfighters, and the Block. After visiting these sites, group members will be given time to visit the city independently before returning to Seville.

Córdoba and Carmona

Córdoba, situated between the shore of the Guadalquivir River and the base of the Sierra Morena mountain, has historically been the capital of the Roman Province of Betica and the Córdoba Islamic Caliphate. From this significant position among these two cultures, marvelous architectural structures such as the Mosque-Cathedral, Roman

Bridge, and Old Jewish Quarter were built and have remained up through the present day. In addition to these most significant sites, there are also a number of lesser archaeological sites located within the city.

On this excursion, the guided group will travel through Córdoba’s old town before arriving at the southern dual carriageway from which the guide will construct visitors as they travel to Carmona, travelling along the same route that will be used to return to Carmona. Here, the guide will reveal a route through the historical helmet of the city while visiting architectural elements such as the Roman bridge (which permits to travel the Guadalquivir river and is famous around

Tangier from Seville

The tour begins with departure from Seville Center to the narrow stretch of Gibraltar. The trip in car or bus lasts approximately 2 hours before arrival at Tarifa, a few kilometers from Morocco. Here the visitors board the ferry which will bring them to the continent of Africa in less than an hour. Doñana and El Rocio

Doñana is a protected natural space situated to the southeast of Andalusia is made up of roughly 116,487 hectares, which allows the group to understand much of Andalusian natural

environment through the natural and National park of Doñana. This space is known to harbor numerous species of mammals and birds, with some of the most prominent animals including the fallow deer and Iberian Lynx. This excursion offers to visitors an ability to understand the profundity of the natural and national park zones (with limited excursion for motor vehicles) while sitting comfortably in a 4x4 and being led by a guide which specializes in the environment.

This tour begins with departure from the city of Sevilla to the locality of Coria del Río, along the shore of the Guadalquivir River, and into the wetlands of Doñana. Here, the group will travel to the northern river marshes, where the group will encounter the largest colony of white storks in Europe. In addition to the white storks this environment also allows visitors to observe thousands of other birds in their natural habitats. Each year, these marshes harbor approximately 200,000 individual birds encompassing more than 300 species which continually meet at the most prestigious natural space on the continent. After visiting this region, the group will be led to Spain's largest rice paddy which has gained additional prominence as the set for the Spanish thriller The Minimal Island. After this visit, the group will continue the excursion by traveling to the northern zone of the national

park which, located close to the village of Rocio, retains an ambiance typical of the far east through its white houses and streets of sand still travelled by horses and men on foot. After the visit to the village of Rocio, the group will discover, accompanied by a guide, the precious palace and the walking trails of the natural park of Doñana as the travel down the stream of the Rocina. Granada and the Alhambra

Granada, famous for its historical constructions (like the Alhambra), for its neighborhoods, for its proximity to the ski station of the Sierra Nevada, and for its gastronomy and tapas culture, is one of the favorite destinations of Naturanda clients.

Starting at dawn, the excursion will cross the heart of Andalusia, starting in the Sevillian countryside and arriving in the grandiose city of Granada. Presiding before the Alhambra, a palatine Andalusian city made up of palaces, gardens, fortresses, and a citadel which accommodated the monarchy and court during the reign of Nazari, Granada offers a grand cultural legacy to all its visitors. Currently, Granada is cataloged as one of the most beautiful palaces in the world and is considered to be one of the most important tourist attractions in Spain.

Its enormous gardens and different rooms reflect distinct religions and cultures which passed through Granada. For this reason, this site is considered to be one of the most important monuments in the country. During the return trip through the monument as

he famous "Rock Tour" begins with an entrance into the nature reserve, where the group performs its first stop at the columns of Hercules. After this visit, the tour will continue to the cave of San Miguel, an incredible grotto within the heart of "The Rock" whose geological formations include stalactities and stalagmites. After completing this initial visit to the cave of San Miguel, the group will travel to the Rock of Gibraltar and learn about the kind, free living monkeys which are unique to this region. To conclude the tour of the nature reserve, the group will visit "The Great Siege Tunnel", a site which was used as a defensive mechanism against invading Spanish and French armies that was excavated by British soliders during XVIII century, and the Arab Castle of Gibraltar.

Land of Arcena, Rio Tinto and Jabugo

Caminito del Rey

The Caminito del Rey is a base that the king of Spain constructed in 1901 for the defence of the Gaitanes (province of Malaga) and to facilitate the completion of maintenance operations within the zone.

In 1921, the structure was renamed "El Caminito del Rey", when King Alfonso XII, after the inauguration of the dam of the Count of Guadalhorce, took the crown. Due to the passage of time and excuse, the structure deteriorated in great measure and became known as one of the most dangerous paths in Europe due to the numerous deaths which

numerous deaths, various reconstruction and rehabilitation plans were initiated in 2014 to improve the safety of travel along the route. In 2015, this goal was reached when a 7 mile trail was opened along the route which eliminated all risks for travelers.

The route to the site traverses the reservoir of Guadalhorce-Guadalteba and the locality of El Chorro. Upon arrival, the group will walk in parallel to railroad tracks as the group approaches the trailhead, where group members will be able to observe the famous gorges of the Gaitanes and Gaitanejos.

The trip to the gorge will begin in Seville and will go to the locality of Ardales. The group will take a 7 kms trip in a conditioned road and free of danger. Once finished, the visitors, accompanied by a Naturanda guide, will take lunch in the zone before returning to Seville. All in all, this tour is perfectly constructed for lovers of nature and of natural hikes.

famous mines and the mouth of the Rio Tinto, known for the reddish color of its waters. Situated in the south of Spain and within the province of Huelva, the route has earned its name due to the meteorological origins of its mineral.

Due to the popularity of this region as a mining zone and the reddish color of its soil, it has been

determined that this region has an astrological origin of more than 5000 years. In this excursion, the discovery of this peculiar landscape marks the beginning of the tour. The city was founded in 206 B.C. by the general Publio Cornelio Escipion (the African), in an indigenously inhabited region of Tudetania. It is known that Italica was the first Roman City founded in Spain and was located within its Italian

animals in Andalusias culture and gastronomy.

From here, clients will travel to the marvelous Aracena locality, where they will be able to enjoy its marvelous rural, natural environments. also part of the set used in the filming of the popular television series Game of Thrones. The Roman theater, discovered in the mid-XX century, is one of the best conserved in Europe while still being maintained in use.

After the visit to the archaeological enclave, the Naturanda guide will accompany their group to the monastery of San Isidoro of Campo, a

Carmona

Carmona, famous for being a medieval village and for the archaeological discoveries from the Roman era which were made here, forms part of a medium length tour which Naturanda organizes where visitors will discover ancient Spanish homes.

At this time, Carmona is considered to be more than 4000 years old, is cataloged as the first Spanish archaeological site opened to the public, and has been given a national heritage award. Within this site of Andalusian origin, there are a number of extremely peculiar tombs such as that of an elephant or the mausoleum of Seville, each of which will be presented to visitors by the company guide.

On this excursion, visitors will be introduced to the main historical monuments located within the Seville locality. Over its four centuries of history, cultures such as the Carthaginians, Romans, Muslims, and Christians have left an important mark on the city's structures and streets. While here, the Naturanda guide will bring visitors from the Alcazar at the door of Seville to the port of Córdoba and, finally, to the Alcazar of Rey don Pedro, now converted into a hostel.

While here, the group will also pass by the old town of the city, travelling the long streets, and observing traditional Andalusian homes while observing numerous Mudejar temples and convents.

Córdoba was the capital of the Roman empire Bética region as well as the regions muslim caliphate, both having left a significant cultural influence on the region. Cathedral and Giralda Tower

In later centuries, the residence of the Spanish royal family was constructed. Included in this structure, it has been designed for use solely by the Spanish royal family, with the exception of tourist visits. And it has been a testament to diverse events related to distinguished Real Alcazar of Seville houses of the Spanish crown as well as the birth of Spanish princes and, subsequently the assassination of bastard sons and kings.

The official Naturanda guide will describe each and every secret and legend of the palace and gardens of the Alcazar, each of which constitutes a fundamental part of the monument. These stories of the city and since their creation have gone through

preserved are the bell tower (the actual Giralda) and its patio.

For more than 150 years, the Christians used the Muslim Temple as a cultural center. In 1401, the Catholic Cabildo decided to construct a new temple. The project was initiated in 1434 and was prolonged until 1508. Here, during the Renaissance period, a series of dependencies annexed to the Gothic cathedral were constructed, such as the main Sacristy, the Capitular room, and the Royal Chapel. Also during this time period the final part of the Giralda was constructed by Hernan Ruiz, reaching a final height of 104 meters and completely visible from every area of the city. At the top, in the XVI century a body of campaigns was added with a statue at the end which a body of campaigns was added with a statue that represents the faith, known as the "Giraldillo", which is known as a candle.

Italica

From the doors of the archaeological enclosure (in the municipality of Santiponce) Naturanda will begin the tour from the Ancient Roman city of Italica. Caminito del Rey

The Caminito del Rey, or the Royal Road, which was originally created to allow for the flow of workers and guards through the area, is situated in the gorge walls of Gaitanes (province of Malaga). The name of the location was changed in 1921 when King Alfonso XI crossed the road, after which he inaugurated the dam of the count of Guadalhorce. However, the passage of time and excuses ensured its decay in a relatively short amount of time, leading to numerous deaths and the eventual title of Caminito del Rey as the most dangerous path in Europe. As a result, however, reconstruction works were commenced in order to rehabilitate the trail, thereby making it perfectly transitable for visitors.

The route elapses between the reservoir of Guadalhorce-Guadalteba and the locality of El Chorro (The Cascade). The group will walk parallel to the railroad tracks while traversing the famous gorges of the Gaitanes and the Gaitanejos.
