## DAY TOURS

### BESAKIH TOUR



### Itinerary

This morning our guide will meet you for a full day excursion to rugged and mountainous eastern Bali. Drive up via Bangli rency for visit The Mother Temple of Besakih. Besakih Temple is the biggest Hindu temple in Bali which the local people call Pura Besakih. It owns

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beautiful view from the top of temple area where we can see the wide nature panorama until to the ocean so that way this temple is many visited by tourists from all over the world.

Besakih Temple is located in Besakih countryside, Rendang sub district, Karangasem regency, east part of the island. It is located in southwest side bevel of mount Agung, the biggest mounts in Bali. It is because pursuant to Agung Mount confidence is holiest and highest mount in Bali Island. From Besakih drive down to Klungkung with stop at local restaurant in Rendang village for having lunch.

After having delicious lunch, continue drive down to visit Goa Lawah (the Bat Cave). From Goa Lawah continue drive to Kerta Gosa (Hall of Justice), featuring a series of 267 painted panels telling the five tales of the Tantri, a Javano-Balinese version of the Pancatantra. Also visit Taman Gili, built around 1686. Drive back to your hotel.

## WONGAYA GEDE VILLAGE

Depart from your hotel around 8AM. Drive to Wongaya Gede village, Tabanan where you will experience the perfect trekking. On the way, you will be enchanted by wonderful view of rice terrace. Make a stop at Mengesta 1 Elementary School where you can interact with kids. Then continue drive to Wongaya Gede Village. Once you arrive at Wongaya Gede village, you will be welcomed by Baleganjur. Baleganjur is a group of people who play Gambelan while walking. The word Baleganjur is from Bale and Ganjur where Bale itself means troops then Ganjur means walk. Start trek down the village pass Balinese house in chill and fresh air. After 3 minutes walking, you will start walk in the rice field. Keep trekking the ups and downs beautiful rice field's path and you will surround by magnificent rice terraces. But don't forget to watch your step and wear comfortable shoes since the path will be slippery after the rain or morning dew. Tracing the path and interact with locals who is still working at the rice field. After 1 hour trek, cross the bamboo bridge and trek up the finish point which located at the top of the hill. You can enjoy rice field panorama with metekap activity (plow over using two cows) by local farmers.

On the finish point, enjoy the traditional snack and having lunch with the view of glorious rice terrace surround by 5 mountains as the background. After lunch, make and prepare an offering which you will bring on the next activity. After the offering ready, take a bath and change into clean clothes and wear a sarong to visit Batukaru Temple. Passing through the countryside and you will be picked up then drive to Batukaru Temple for a blessing by the priest. Batukaru temple, referred to by locals as Pura Luhur Batukaru, is one of Bali's key temples, located at the foot of Mount Batukaru. At an altitude of 2,270m above sea level on

the second highest peak in Bali after Mount Agung, the temple is surrounded by cool natural forest. After the blessing ceremony by the priest, drive down to the village to enjoy dinner served in the Dulang, a carved or painted pedestal plate at local house. Your dinner also will be entertained by Joged Bumbung Dance by the locals. Joged Bumbung dance is traditional social dance used to performed in social event such as wedding. The dancer is woman and will ask one of the audiences to dance with her. After dinner, return to your hotel.

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## UBUD VILLAGE – TANAH LOT TOUR



This morning after breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel for a full-day tour of Ubud. Leave your hotel and then drive to visit Wenara wana also known as Ubud Monkey Forest which is a nature reserve and a temple complex located in Ubud. This place is habitat of approximately 340 long-tailed monkeys. There are four groups of monkeys who occupy different areas in this park. Monkey forest is a well known tourist attraction in Ubud. (It has become more popular, since Queen Elizabeth II and the Prince of England visited the village a few years ago). Then visit Ubud Market, Ubud Art Market or the Ubud Art Market places selling souvenirs Bali. This place became one of Bali's premier tourist destinations for domestic and foreign tourists. Fresh produce such as fruits, vegetables, poultry and local snacks can be purchased from the wet market. It is located in the basement of the building. Ubud Palace is a royal palace of Ubud with beautiful Balinese traditional houses as a residence of Ubud King.

Then drive to Pejeng Village for visiting Pengukur – ukur temple. Pengukur – ukur Temple is believed to be the place to measure the strength of Bali in the past. In this place the ability of Kebo Iwa has been measured before becoming mahapatih kingdom of ancient Bali. Next on to Tanah Lot is a rock formation off the Indonesian island of Bali. It is home to the pilgrimage temple Pura Tanah Lot, a popular tourist and cultural icon for photography and general exoticism.

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## KINTAMANI & BESAKIH TOUR



### Itinerary

This Morning, our guide will meet you at hotel to have a full day island excursion. Leave your hotel and drive to Batubulan village to attend Barong and Keris traditional dance performance. Proceed to Goa Gajah (Elephant Cave), a Hindu meditation center dating back to the 11th Century. Then, continue to Tampak Siring to see the Holy Spring Water Temple Tirta Empul. Spring water of Tirta Empul is believed to have magical power by the Balinese to purify from sins, to give youth and to heal diseases. Next onto view the magnificent Panorama of the still active Mt. Batur volcano, famous for its great eruption in 1917 which destroyed many villages and took countless of life. The older local people remember this year as "the time when the world shook". But now, lots of people come to admire the beauty of this volcano and the area surround it. You will also see Batur Lake, Bali's largest lake with an area of approximately 18 square kilometers.

Continue drive for visit Besakih the mother temple. Besakih Temple is the biggest Hindu temple in Bali which the local people call Pura Besakih. It owns beautiful view from the top of temple area where we can see the wide nature panorama until to the ocean so that way this temple is many visited by tourists from all over the world. 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## ULUWATU TOUR – KECAK AND DINNER



### Itinerary

You will be picked up from your hotel in the afternoon. Visit Pura Luhur Uluwatu or Pura Uluwatu is a Balinese sea temple located in Uluwatu – South Kuta, Badung. The temple is regarded as one of the sad kahyangan and is dedicated to Sang Hyang Widhi Wasa in his manifestation as Rudra. The temple is built at the edge (ulu) of a 70 meter high cliff or rock (watu) projecting into the sea.

Continue to attend Kecak Dance Performance. Bali Kecak Dance is a spectacular traditional dance, which tells the story of Ramayana dances with a group of people playing with bonfire. It is very interesting and unique dance because it does not use gamelan as normally, but use their mouths with sound (chak, chak, chak). The dancers make compact choir with a beautiful dance movement which is one of the features of this dance. This story is usually used for this dance is taken from the Ramayana. Dinner will be served at at Seafood Restaurant in Jimbaran.

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## MENGWI - KEDATON & TANAH LOT TOUR



## Itinerary

This morning after breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel. Visit the Royal Temple of Pura Taman Ayun, built in 1634—it's considered one of the most beautiful temples and garden with water features located in Mengwi district in Badung Regency. Then continue to holy monkey forest at Kedaton - noted for its temples inhabited by colonies of friendly monkeys. Next on to Tanah Lot temple is a rock formation off the Indonesian island of Bali. It is home to the pilgrimage temple *Pura Tanah Lot*, a popular tourist and cultural icon for photography and general exoticism.

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## TABANAN VILLAGE TOUR



## Itinerary

This morning you will be picked up from the hotel by your guide for exploration of the Tabanan Regency of Bali. Your journey will start to visit Tanah Lot Temple is a rock formation off the Indonesian island of Bali. It is home to the pilgrimage temple *Pura Tanah Lot*, a popular tourist and cultural icon for photography and general exoticism. Continue on to Pejaten Village to see the manufacture of red bricks and roof tiles traditionally. Pejaten villager daily activities are making red bricks and roof tiles. Next visit to museum Ceramics Pejaten called "Tantris Museum". You may experience to make a ceramic or see the production of the ceramics. In addition, they are also making ceramics for sale. Next on to



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butterfly park, to see collection of butterflies, besides butterflies you also can see many kinds of grasshoppers and beetles.

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## DENPASAR CITY TOUR



Visit the art center at Abian Kapas, the Bali Museum at Renon, a local market and the suburbs of Denpasar - the Capital City of Bali.

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## UBUD VILLAGE ART CRAFTS TOUR



Driving North this tour will show you the daily lives of the people of Batubulan where the locals carve stones to be statue in any form. Then stop at Kemenuh, a village famous for its wood carvers. Proceed to Ubud, where you visit the homes of artists and have opportunity

to see them at work. Other point of interests you may visit Painting Museum, where modern Balinese paintings one display. Wenara Wana - a small forest nearby inhabited by a group of playful monkeys; Pengosekan, a village well known for its handicrafts (It has become more popular, since Queen Elizabeth II and Prince of Great Britain visited this village a couple of years ago).

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## KINTAMANI VOLCANO AND LAKE TOUR



Drive to Batubulan village to attend Barong and Keris dance performance. Then visit the art and handicraft villages of Celuk, Batuan, Mas and Ubud, to witness gold and silver work, hand weaving woodcarving and painting. Proceed to Goa Gajah (Elephant Cave), a Hindu meditation center dating back to the 11th Century, Then Tampak Siring to see the holy spring water temple Tirta Empul. Next on to view the magnificent Panorama of the still active Mt. Batur volcano and Lake Batur. Return through other route according to local happenings.
